
Complete your **Service Learning/Capstone project** at **North Central District Health Department** in *O'Neill*

Accreditation Readiness

RESPONSIBILITIES

The student will work with the Accreditation Team and PHAB staff to:

- Review health department programs to determine gaps for accreditation
- Prepare and organize materials to assist with accreditation readiness
- Select potential documentation for accreditation

Veterans Services

RESPONSIBILITIES

The student will work with the Veterans Services Coordinator, veterans, service members and their families, and community organizations to:

- Assist with outreach events and referral process
- Assist with dissemination of screening tools

Community Health Assessment / Community Health Improvement Plan

RESPONSIBILITIES

The student will work with the CHIP team, including community organizations, to:

- Develop work plan content
- Implement activities for priority health areas identified through the community health assessment
- Periodically review progress and develop progress reports
- Assist with ongoing data collection, monitoring, and evaluation needs
- Assist in communicating with community for reporting progress and increasing awareness/participation

Influenza Immunizations

RESPONSIBILITIES

The student will work with all on site NCDHD staff and community members to:

- Provide flu shots (if licensed)
- Assist with flu shot clinics and logistics

RESPONSIBILITIES

The student will work with the Worksite Wellness Coordinator, nursing staff, and district businesses to:

- Contact district businesses to encourage development of worksite wellness programs
- Provide technical assistance and support to local businesses with worksite wellness programs
