The state of Arizona has canceled a vaccine education program after receiving complaints from parents who don't vaccinate their children.

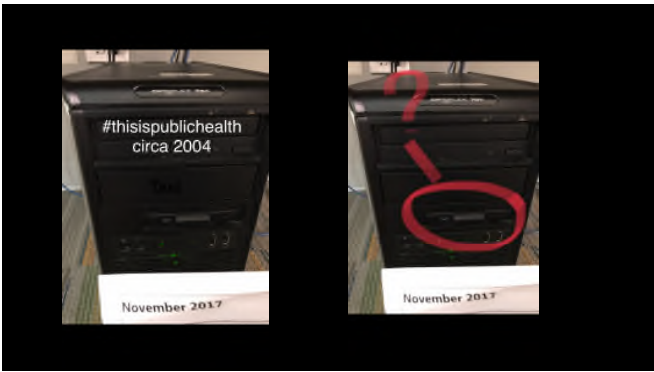

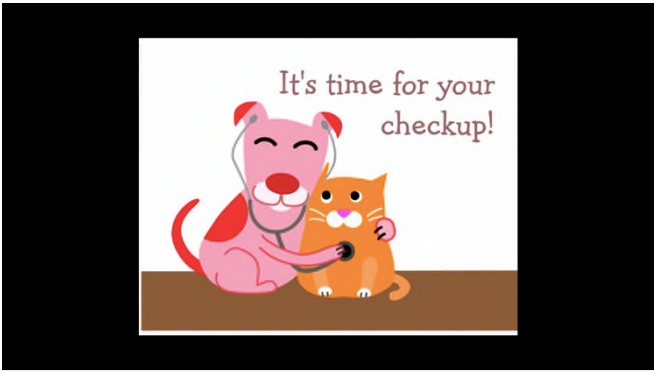

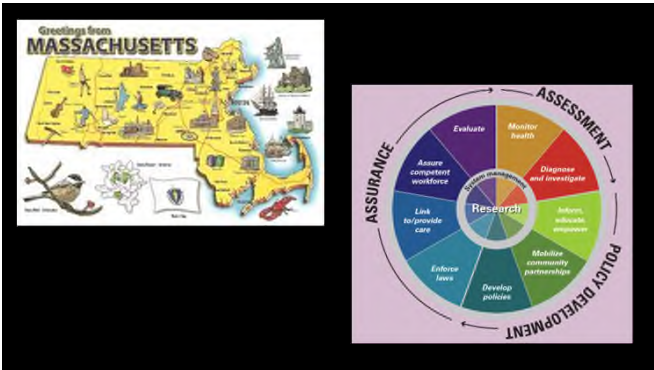
