





Nebraska Drug Overdose Health Burden Nebraska's drug overdose death rate has increased over the last decade – 9.8 overdose deaths for every 100,000 people in 2017 up from 3.6 in 2004. The U.S. drug overdose death rate per 100,000 people was 21.7 in 2017 up from 9.3 in 2004. 2017: 183 people in Nebraska died of a drug overdose At least 59 involved opioids 2016: 128 people in Nebraska died of a drug overdose At least 38 involved opioids























Good Samaritan Law LB 487 (2017) — Protects a person who makes a good faith request for emergency medical assistance in response to a drug overdose of himself, herself, or another as soon as the drug overdose was apparent; Requesting person remain on the scene until medical assistance or law enforcement personnel arrive and cooperate with medical assistance and law enforcement personnel.
